- Founded in 2008
- Vision to build a major, utility-scale wind development
- Started *in Wyoming by Wyoming* people
- Headquartered in Cheyenne

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Project Summary



- Nearly 100,000 acres in Platte & Goshen Counties
 - Will & Emma Farms
 - 100% private land
 - Premier road and rail access
 - World class wind
- Space to produce +/- 2,500 MW
 - Started company with a 1,000 turbine goal

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Why Platte County?

- Wind resource
- Transportation access
- Low environmental concern
- More private vs. Federal land
- Over 10,000 MW of proposed transmission

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Current Studies



- Permitting and Environmental Studies
 - CH2M Hill
- Wind Resource Analysis
 - V-Bar Wind Energy Consulting

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Biological Studies



- Commenced in March 2011
- Our approved study plan was built in conjunction with the WGFD and USFW
- Pre-construction studies will last 2 years
- Conservation plan will be developed with input from WGFD and landowners

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Wind Studies



- Emma Farm
 - Seven met towers
 - Second Wind Triton SODAR
 - Study began in March 2010
- Will Farm
 - Six met towers
 - Study began in November 2010

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Development Timeframe



- Leasing complete – 2011
- Wind Studies – 2010-2012
- Environmental, Socioeconomic, and Permitting Studies– 2011-2013
- Planning (engineering & surveying) – 2012-2013
- Industrial Siting Hearing – late 2013
- Commencement of construction – 2014
- **1st phase in service – early 2016**
