Safety/Work Readiness Customized Core Program

This two week (80 hour) program provides a core foundation in safety and work readiness for employees in the oil industry. Participants receive training/certifications in **OHSA 10, Safeland, H2S, Environmental Issues, CPR and Professionalism**. In addition, participants receive an industry introduction through **Oil/Gas 101**, examine the critical importance of a safety mindset in **Creating a Safety Culture**, and receive basic computer skills training.
